For Immediate Release (May 5, 2017, 11:50 a.m.): Flooding in areas within the Thompson-Nicola Regional District has resulted in various road closures, including major highway accesses.

Rodeo Drive in the community of Cherry Creek is currently closed. The TNRD is currently working with the Ministry of Transportation to investigate alternative access routes for this area. Further information will be provided as soon as alternatives can be arranged.
