For Immediate Release (August 26, 2017 – 2:00 p.m.): The TNRD Kamloops Emergency Social Services (ESS) Reception Centre at the Sandman Centre, located at 300 Lorne Street, will be operating under new hours to best meet the current ESS activity, including evacuee service renewals.

The Kamloops ESS Reception Centre will be open the following hours:

- Monday, August 28 Closed
- Tuesday, August 29 10am-12pm
- Wednesday, August 30 Closed
- Thursday, August 31 Closed
- Friday, September 1 10am-12pm
- Saturday, September 2 Closed
- Sunday, September 3 Closed
- Monday, September 4 Closed
- Tuesday, September 5 10am-12pm

The ESS continues to assist renewing evacuees and these hours will be adjusted as needed should conditions change.
