# Re-entry Meeting for Loon Lake Property Owners

**For Immediate Release (August 19, 2017 – 12:00 p.m.):** A meeting has been scheduled to provide Loon Lake area property owners with information about returning home when the Evacuation Order is rescinded for that area.

The Evacuation Order for the Loon Lake area that went into effect on July 14 is being rescinded effective 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 20, 2017. The re-entry meeting being arranged for property owners is to provide important information about returning after such an extended absence.

All property owners from the Loon Lake area are invited to attend to receive information from BC Wildfire, RCMP, Thompson-Nicola Regional District, Loon Lake Volunteer Fire Department and some of the non-government agencies such as United Way, Canadian Red Cross, etc. Representatives will be on hand to provide information and answer questions.
