Resiliency Centre to Open in Kamloops at Soccer Central Lounge, McArthur Island

For Immediate Release (July 12, 2017 – 9:35 p.m.): The Thompson Nicola Regional District (TNRD) will open a resiliency centre starting tomorrow, Thursday, July 13, at 12, noon. It will be open until 4:00 p.m.

Starting on Friday, July 14, the centre will be open seven days a week, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. The resiliency centre will be located at the City of Kamloops' Soccer Central Lounge and Meeting Room at 1550 Island Parkway, on McArthur Island. Evacuees are encouraged to check the centre's hours on the TNRD's website (www.tnrd.ca) before visiting.

The resiliency centre will provide resources for evacuees, including insurance advice from the Insurance Bureau of Canada and insurers. The centre will also house a variety of non-governmental agencies (NGOs) that will be able to provide services for evacuees. Service Canada will also be located at the centre.

The TNRD covers 11 municipalities (Ashcroft, Barriere, Cache Creek, Chase, Clearwater, Clinton, Kamloops, Logan Lake, Lytton, Merritt and Sun Peaks) and 10 Electoral Areas - "A" (Wells Gray Country), "B" (Thompson Headwaters), "E" (Bonaparte Plateau), "I" (Blue Sky Country), "J" (Copper Desert Country), "L", "M", "N", "O" (Lower North Thompson) and "P" (Rivers and the Peaks). The TNRD provides over 120 services including planning and building inspection, solid waste management, emergency preparedness and 9-1-1 services, recreation, utilities, television river buoys, transit, tourism, library services and operates a film commission.
