Update on Flooding Events in the TNRD

For Immediate Release (May 6, 2017, 0945): The TNRD Emergency Operations Centre remains open today to support residents impacted by flooding events in the region.

Plans are underway to check on residents on Rodeo Drive in Cherry Creek that are currently without power. Rodeo Drive has been washed out and an alternative access is in place for local traffic only.

Properties currently under Evacuation Order in Cherry Creek are also being checked. Any resident under Evacuation Order can call 1-888-800-6493 for assistance with lodging, food, etc. For other impacted residences in Cherry Creek additional sandbagging supplies have been delivered. These additional supplies are being delivered to the Cherry Creek Ranch location.

Conditions continue to be monitored in a number of other impacted locations within the Regional District, including areas such as Turtle Valley, Mill Creek and Westwold. TNRD residents are reminded that if you are in an areas affected by flooding and are in imminent danger, evacuate immediately.
