Encompassing an unparalleled geographic region in the heart of British Columbia, the Thompson-Nicola Regional District (TNRD) offers the best of both worlds. Urban life within vibrant communities and outlying rural regions that showcase the region's beauty - pristine but rugged mountains, rolling grasslands, lush evergreen forests and both historic and modern areas, all within approximately 45,000 square kilometres. Headquartered in the City of Kamloops, the TNRD provides a wide range of local government services to a population of 130,000 located within its 11 diverse municipalities and 10 electoral areas.

The Role:

Reporting to the Environmental Services Operations Supervisor, the Environmental Services Technologist I will support and enhance TNRD solid waste operations. This position is one of two Environmental Services Technologist I positions which support the day-to-day operations at the two active landfills, 28 transfer stations, and numerous closed landfills (under environmental monitoring) that make up the TNRD solid waste management system. This role requires a self-starter and organized individual who can work both alone and in a team environment.

Primary Expectations of the Role include:

- Inspection of solid waste facilities to ensure contract compliance. Specifically ensuring contract staff are adhering to TNRD procedures and policies
- Coordination of service contracts such as waste/recycling hauling, site maintenance, snow removal, facility repairs and improvements
- Adherence to assigned budget, ensuring best value to TNRD
- Ensure compliance with health and safety requirements
- Provide recommendations and input to the Environmental Services Operations Supervisor to solve problems and improve existing operations

Required Education and Experience

- Completion of an undergraduate degree in natural resource science, engineering, environmental studies, or a related field
- Two (2) years of related experience in solid waste management
- Specialized training in solid waste management, such as certification by the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA), is an asset
- An equivalent combination of education, training and experience may be considered
- Experience working in public sector - Local government experience an asset
- Proven experience directing contractors and adhering to assigned budget required
- Knowledge of solid waste management in BC
- Valid Class 5 Drivers Licence

Required Skills and Abilities

- Project management and contract administration skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Proficient using computers/devices and ability to learn new systems/technology
- Good written and oral communication
- Organized, problem solving abilities, and critical thinker
