Information on Evacuated Livestock and Pets

For Immediate Release (June 8, 2017 – 4:00 p.m.): To support residents that have been evacuated, plans have been put into place for livestock and pets.

Residents that have been evacuated from the North Thompson area should bring their livestock to Barriere Fall Fair Grounds.

Residents that have been evacuated from the areas around Ashcroft and Cache Creek should bring their livestock to the BC Livestock Producers Co-operative Association yard at 10145 Dallas Drive in Kamloops.

If evacuees have household pets that need housing, Canadian Disaster Animal Response Team (CDART) is setting up an animal reception centre at 5 Star Dog Training facility at 340D – 12th Avenue, Kamloops, BC. The reception centre is expected to open later this evening.
