Re-entry Meeting for Property Owners

For Immediate Release (September 14, 2017 – 8:00 p.m.): A meeting has been scheduled to provide property owners with information about returning home after an extended evacuation. This meeting is open to any property owner that has recently returned in the South Green Lake area, as well as those in areas who will be returning to their properties this weekend when the Evacuation Order is rescinded for their areas.

The Evacuation Orders currently in place for the Hihium, Young, Pressy and Little Pressy Lake areas are being rescinded effective 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 16, 2017. The re-entry meeting being arranged for property owners is to provide important information about returning after an extended absence. This meeting will also provide residents that have recently returned to their property in the South Green Lake area with information and provide an opportunity for them to ask any questions they may have.

All property owners in the area are invited to attend to receive information from agencies such as BC Wildfire, RCMP, Thompson-Nicola Regional District and some of the non-government agencies such as United Way, Canadian Red Cross, etc. Representatives will be on hand to provide information and answer questions.
