



## Evacuation Orders for West of Eagan Lake, Sharpe Lake, and Deadman-Vidette Areas Rescinded Effective Immediately

### For Immediate Release (September 11, 2017 – 7:00 p.m.):

While the Elephant Hill Wildfire remains active in some areas of the Thompson-Nicola region, the imminent threat posed by the fire has currently diminished to the point that property owners West of Eagan Lake, and in the Sharpe Lake and Deadman-Vidette areas can return to their properties effective immediately. A map of the areas that are being downgraded from Order to Alert are attached. The specific addresses that are no longer on Evacuation Order are:

Residents are reminded that these areas remain on Evacuation Alert. While the Elephant Hill Wildfire remains active, residents need to stay vigilant and must be prepared to leave at any time. Residents will be given as much advance warning as possible prior to an evacuation; however at times only limited notice can be provided due to changing conditions.

There are areas within the TNRD that remain on Evacuation Order, so travel remains limited in these areas. The areas that remain on Evacuation Order will continue to be reviewed regularly.

A re-entry package is available to residents that provides important information to be aware of when returning home after an extended evacuation.
